### VI. 2009 HSG

- a. Determine Project Status
  - 1. Generator/Tower remediation

Project ongoing, cost to finish \$18,000

2. State Patrol Interoperability

All counties in attendance will participate on this project with the assumption that Polk and Saunders will want to also. Cost of this project is \$144,000

3. Interoperable Channel base Stations

Will need 3 base stations in the region to provide coverage needed. Balance of 2009 funds would go toward I 1 or more base stations with the rest coming from 2010 HSG

4. Purchase of computers for Colfax, Butler, Nance, Merrick, and Howard Dispatch Center for Paraclete access

Colfax County requested a computer to be used for Paraclete access.

5. FTK software

Funding for Columbus Police Dept. to send an investigator to the specialize training and software required to do forensic investigation of computer hard drives. Within reason this service provided by Columbus Police Dept. will be available to regional law enforcement agencies. The cost of the software and training is \$8000. Colfax motion, Butler second.
